GLOBAL FOOTBALL DEVELOPMENT PARTICIPANT CODE OF CONDUCT



This code of conduct outlines the expectations, high standards, and values of all players participating in Global Football Development programmes. We all play a part in creating an environment that is safe, fun and enjoyable for all players.

As a Global Football Development player, I will:

- Play fairly, to the best of my ability, and for the benefit of my team.
- Be inspirational, displaying a positive, encouraging, and friendly attitude to other players and coaches.
- Treat all individuals with respect, creating an environment that is free of fear, discrimination and harassment.
- Speak to my coach (or the head coach) if my experience is being negatively affected by others and/or I feel unhappy, so they can help support me.
- Strive for excellence by being polite to others, on time for training, and bringing the correct kit and equipment to each session.
- Listen carefully to my coaches, following their instructions and guidance whilst treating them with respect.
- Respect the facilities and equipment both on and off the pitch.
- Notify my coach if I am feeling unwell, need to use the toilet, or have sustained an injury.
- Talk to someone I trust, if I feel unsafe or any other concern that is making me unhappy.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, my parents or carer will be made aware if appropriate, and I may:

- Be asked to provide a verbal or written apology to whoever I have upset.
- Be excluded from taking part in any activity (such as playing games).
- Receive a formal warning.
- Be suspended from training.
